## Measuring Tips

An Anglian qualified surveyor will carry out an exact survey prior to manufacture and in the event of your products being over, or under measured, the contract price will be amended accordingly.

This document will take you through the simple process step-by-step!

## Handy tips for measuring your products accurately and safely

1 You will need a tape measure, ruler or straight edge, paper and a pen or pencil.

2 If possible, get someone from within your household to help.

3 Record all measurements in centimetres and try to be as accurate as possible. Measure each dimension twice as an extra check.

4 Do not attempt to measure areas you cannot reach safely.

## Measuring Guide Windows

## How should I measure my windows?

1 Design and draw your new windows as viewed from the INSIDE of the room.

2 Measure your window from INSIDE of the room, recording all measurements in centimetres.

3 WIDTH: Measure from REVEAL to REVEAL and add 5 cm for the plaster line to the measurement.

4 HEIGHT: Measure from the underside of the window CILL to the HEAD of the window and add 5 cm for the plaster line to the measurement.

## How should I measure my bay window?

## IMPORTANT

Please measure each section of your bay windows from the INSIDE.

1 Design and draw your bay window as viewed from the INSIDE of the room.

2 Measure your bay windows from INSIDE of the room, recording all measurements in centimetres.

3 WIDTH AND DEPTH: Refer to the Bay Window Designs and measure all widths and depths indicated with X .

4 HEIGHT: Measure from the underside of the window CILL to the HEAD of the window and add 5 cm for the plaster line to the measurement.
